

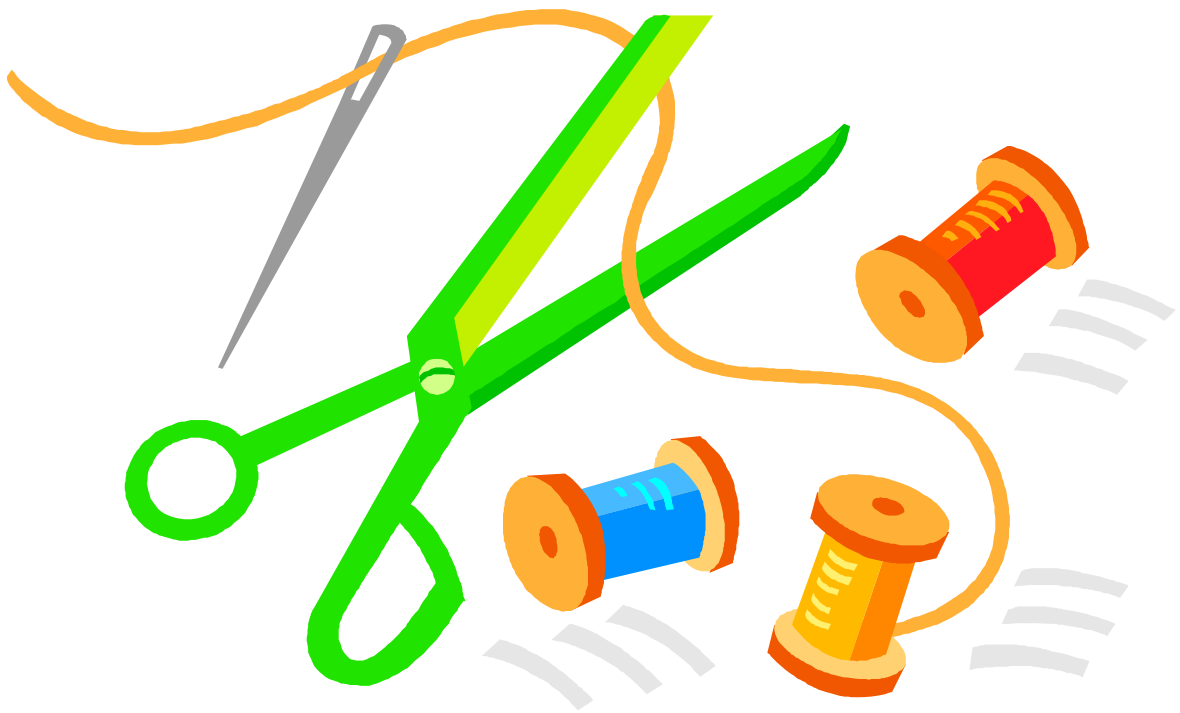
Brown Bag Demonstrations
Quickie Sewing Kit
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Supplies Needed:

- Items for kit
- Newspaper
- Cleansing tissues
- Scissors

What to Do	What to Say
Chart #1	An easy-to-make sewing kit that can be carried in a purse or suitcase is a great gift to make for mom, aunt, grandmother, sister, or friend.
Chart #2	<p>Items needed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Empty lipstick or chap stick case • Piece of cloth about 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ x 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " • Needles and any color thread • Straight pins • Safety pins <p>Clean out the lipstick left in the case. Cleansing tissues, cotton or Q-tips are good for this. Be sure to do it over a newspaper so as not to make a mess. Cut the piece of cloth 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ x 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches or to fit the empty case. Flannel or felt cloth is good to use.</p> <p>Fasten several needles, straight pins and safety pins to the cloth. Cut lengths of different colored thread about 12 inches long. Wrap the pieces loosely around the needles.</p> <p>Roll the piece of cloth with pins and needles on the inside and insert in the empty case.</p>
